<p><b>Topic Description (30%):</b> The topic is clearly identified. Description conveys understanding of the topic, its applications, and its significance.</p>					
<p><b>Goal &amp; Plan (30%):</b> Clearly identifies the medium for the project. Outlines a plan for its completion. Demonstrates careful thought in identifying the essential components or steps; also, any outstanding needs or gaps in understanding, and plans for how to meet them.</p>					
<p><b>Annotated references (30%):</b> Includes at least three sources that are relevant to the topic and are referenced in a consistent style. Each reference is accompanied by a concise summary of the source's main ideas, arguments, evidence, claims, and conclusions; also, an assessment of the quality of the source's content.</p>					
<p><b>Presentation (10%):</b> No/very few typographical errors. Format is clean and well-organized with an appropriate font face. Concise document contains between 500 and 1200 words.</p>
