Annotated references (30%): Includes at least three sources that are relevant to the topic and are referenced in a consistent style. Each reference is accompanied by a concise summary of the source's main ideas, arguments, evidence, claims, and conclusions; also, an assessment of the quality of the source's content.					
Presentation (10%):  No/very few typographical errors. Format is clean and well-organized with an appropriate font face.  Concise document contains between 500 and 1200 words.
